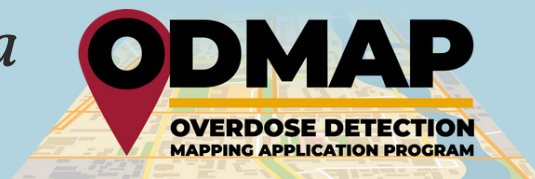


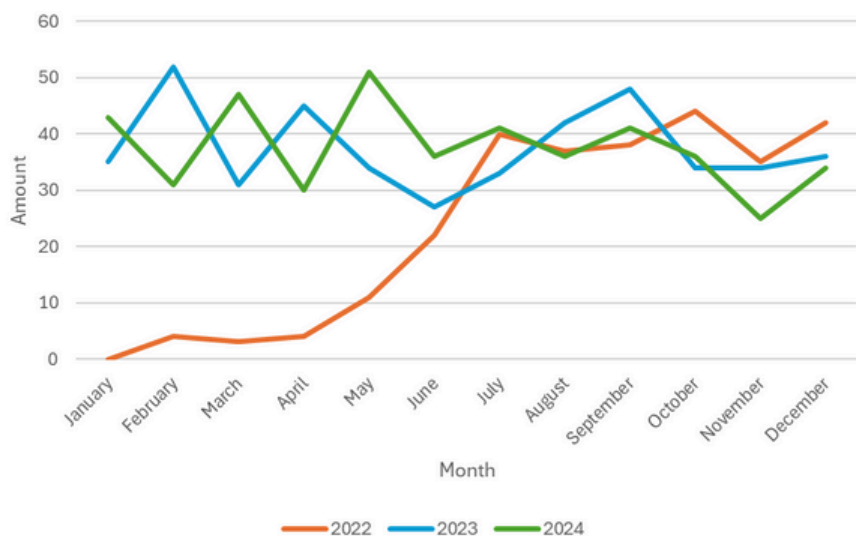
# Regional Suspected Overdose Data

Data for Ballard, Calloway, Carlisle, Fulton, Graves, Hickman, Marshall, and McCracken Counties

Regional Aggregated Suspected ODs CY 22-24



In 2024, the region recorded a total of **451** suspected overdoses, with **May** being the highest month, accounting for **51** incidents.

In 2023, the region recorded a total of **451** suspected overdoses, with **February** being the highest month, accounting for **52** incidents.

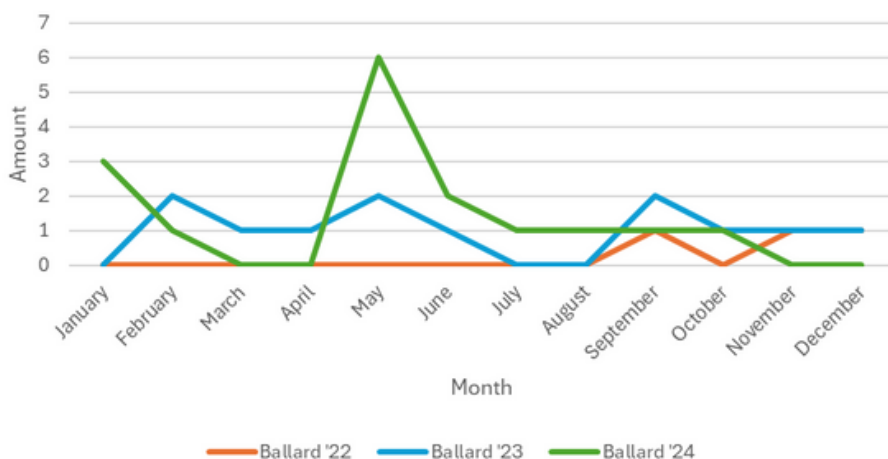
In 2022, the region recorded a total of **280** suspected overdoses, with **October** being the highest month, accounting for **44** incidents.

**Ballard County** had a total of **16** suspected overdoses in 2024.

**May** marked the highest recorded month for Ballard County, with a total of **6** incidents.

The population of Ballard County, Kentucky in 2022 was **7,650**. (usafacts.org)

Ballard Co. Suspected ODs CY 22-24



ODMAP is a HIDTA software that provides near real-time suspected overdose data from EMS and law enforcement. PDHD uses this information for hotspot analysis and targeted outreach.

**Naloxone (narcan)** is an opioid antagonist, used to reverse an opioid overdose. This medication, fentanyl and xylazine test strips, and educational material are distributed during outreach events.



Signs/symptoms of an opioid overdose:

- Pin Point Pupils
- Blue Lips and nails
- Shallow/absent breathing
- Cold/Clammy Skin
- Unresponsive
